

## An Internationally Recognized Business School

The School of Management is recognized for its faculty research and academic programs.

- *BusinessWeek* ranks the school's Executive MBA program No. 1 among public university programs in Texas, No. 6 among public university Executive MBA programs in the U.S., and No. 22 worldwide.
- *Financial Times* has ranked the Executive MBA program No. 1 among public university programs in Texas for three consecutive years.
- *BusinessWeek* ranks the school's Professional Part-Time MBA program No. 1 in Texas and No. 8 among public university professional part-time programs in the U.S.
- *U.S. News & World Report* ranks the school's Full-Time MBA program No. 23 among public university programs in the U.S. and in the top 50 programs in the U.S.
- *BusinessWeek* ranks the School of Management's undergraduate programs No. 39 among public university business schools in the U.S. and No. 30 in overall student satisfaction.

### Our Beginnings

UT Dallas was established in 1969 by Cecil Green, J. Erik Jonsson and Eugene McDermott, the founders of Texas Instruments, who envisioned a university that would offer innovative teaching and research.

UT Dallas has grown from an enrollment of 45 graduate students in 1970 to almost 16,000 graduate and undergraduate students in 2009. The School of Management is the largest of UT Dallas' seven schools.
